# Developing an Effective Syllabus, Part I – The Syllabus as a Communication Tool

The style of a syllabus tends to fall along a continuum of...

### Processing Break One: What does your course syllabus communicate to learners?

- Does the syllabus create a positive first impression of you and the course?
- What do you appear to value?
- What do you believe about teaching and learning?
- What are the important course policies?
- What is emphasized?
- What is minimized?

Consider course policies Incorporate inclusivity and wellness statements Include a personal teaching statement Reframe language in student-friendly terms

What is one small change you could make that would improve the tone of your syllabus?




### Developing an Effective Syllabus, Part II – The Syllabus as a Tool for Learning

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
#### Processing Break Two: How can your syllabus be used as a tool for learning?

- What are the overall goals for this course?
- How do students practice--both in and out of class?
- How do students demonstrate mastery?
- What are the "milestones" throughout the semester?

Consider course goals

- Align goals, practice, and assessment tasks
- Provide adequate practice
- Include a clear course calendar
- Share milestones with students

## Developing an Effective Syllabus, Part III – The Syllabus as a Marketing Tool

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#### Processing Break Three: How can your syllabus be used to inspire and motivate?

- Why is this course relevant?
- What will be gained by taking this course?
- What is exciting about this content?
- What would make this work a priority?

Operate from a marketing perspective Use an encouraging and engaging tone Explain the relevance Share your enthusiasm for the subject Include a section of "How to be successful"

How might you revise the syllabus to convey your passion or show relevance for the subject?
