



#### TIPS FOR USING CHAT GPT

Al/ChatGPT can provide answers and accept raw data in a table format. To have ChatGPT provide answers in a table format, prompt the bot to "Present the information in a table format?" To have ChatGPT provide information to ChatGPT in a table format, use columns and rows to organize the data in a

spreadsheet or a simple text file and copy and paste it into the ChatGPT chat prompt box.

#### **Ideas for Using this Format**

**Create a Course Schedule**: ChatGPT can create a table showing the schedule for the entire semester, including dates of each class, assignments, exams and other important events.

**Course Materials and Readings**: ChatGPT can create a table showing the required course materials and readings for each class session or unit, including the titles, authors and publication dates.

**Course Outcomes and Objectives**: ChatGPT can create a table showing the learning outcomes and objectives for the course, outlining the skills, knowledge and competencies that students should be able to demonstrate by the end of the semester.

**Learning Activities and Assessments**: ChatGPT can create a table showing the learning activities and assessments for each unit or module of the course, including the format, duration, and objectives of each activity or assessment.
