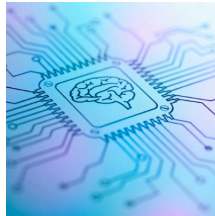

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# Learning More About Canvas: How Do I Assign Extra Credit?

Have you ever wanted or needed to add extra credit to an assignment or test? There is no extra credit default tool in Canvas, but there are multiple ways to add extra credit to course grades. Give it a try!



- Add a zero-point assignment set to “No admissions” type. Points added will be extra credit.
- Manually edit an existing gradebook value to reflect the extra points, even above the point value of the assignment.
- You can add “fudge points” to completed quizzes for individual students in SpeedGrader.
- Use rubrics (1). You can add an “extra credit” criterion to a rubric that makes the point value of the rubric more than that of the assignment. [the assignment is worth 20 pts.; the total points possible in the rubric is 25].
- Use rubrics (2). Simply add more points to a criterion than the point value indicated.
