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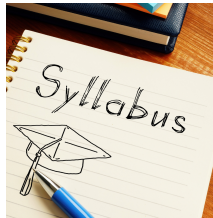

Learning More About Canvas: Importing Courses from Blackboard, or Another LMS into Canvas

Have you ever created courses with another LMS and wished that these courses could be imported into Canvas? Guess what? In many cases you can! Give it a try!



- LMS imports include Moodle, D2L, Angel Bb Vista/CE, WebCT 6+ and Blackboard 6/7/8/9 into Canvas.
- For Blackboard LMS, you must have a Blackboard 6/7/8/9 export zip file that you previously exported.
- Other LMS products have their own export tools and formats that allow you to export and store course content. Check out these products' help pages for information on exporting content.
- There are instructions for importing these and other supported formats under the Topic, "Course Import Tool."
- Each supported LMS product has its own tutorial and procedure for importing course material into Canvas in the left menu of the link below.
