3. ONLINE AND HYBRID TEACHING RESOURCES

Teaching online or HyFlex, when thoughtfully planned, can be very engaging and effective across subjects and disciplines. Canvas provides two different quiz engines for conducting online quizzes, New and Classic. The Classic quiz engine, used since OSU adopted Canvas, will remain in place until Spring 2024.
